



1. What information is required?

All you need to make a SEPA credit transfer is your IBAN (International Bank Account Number) and your BIC (also called SWIFT code). The IBAN is composed of your regular bank account number and your sort code. Added to this is the standard country code DE (for Germany) and the two-digit check code calculated for each IBAN.

2. Where can I find my IBAN and BIC?


You can find your IBAN and BIC on your statement or in your account information in eBanking, or on your Wirecard Bank AG girocard.

3. Where can I find the payee's IBAN and BIC?

You can only obtain the bank details from the payee – for example, their invoice or letterhead. If you cannot find these details, just ask the payee directly.
